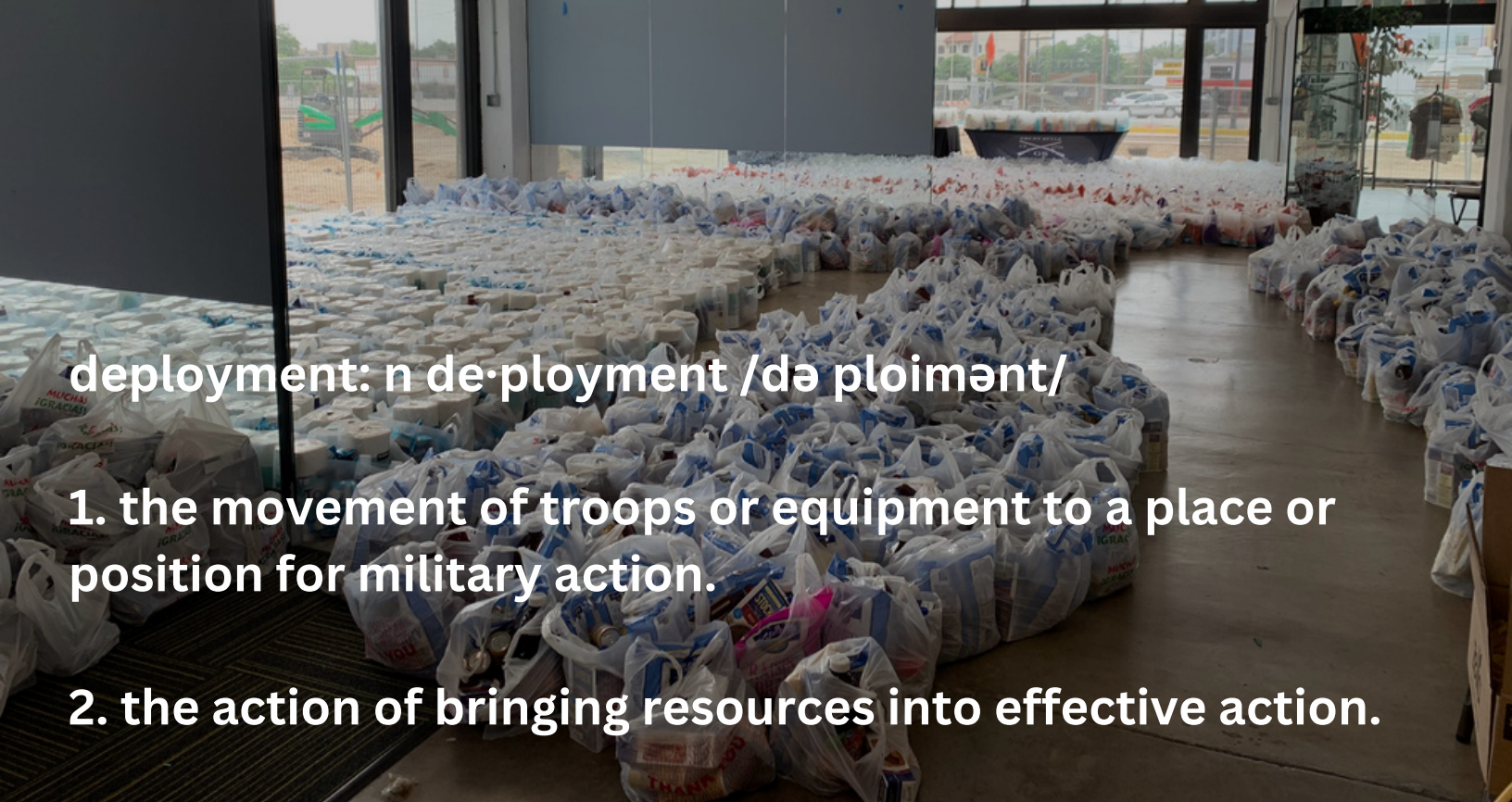

Serving military installations across the United States, Grunt Style Foundation offers helpful resources and support to these brave men and women, demonstrating its vast respect and support.

Each deployment pushes out over 42,000 pounds of food to our junior enlisted families.

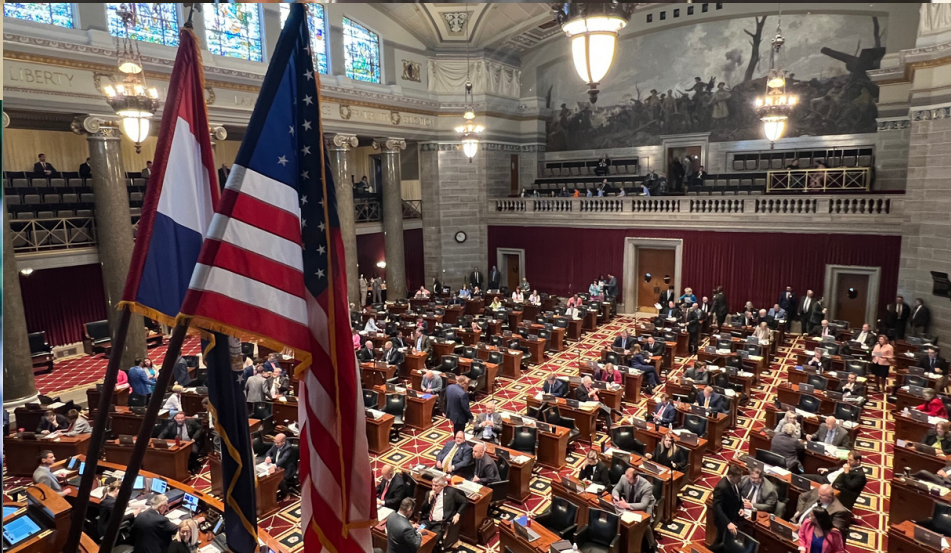




Advocacy
